

Vision, Mission and Action Plan of the departments were assessed as a very important facet of the audit system to work upon them for formulating a larger Action Plan for Remuna Degree College.

Significant Findings: 2019-20

The findings of the academic audit (Department wise) are as below:

Departments in Arts Stream

Economics:

The department has tree regular faculty members to cater to the needs +3 degree honours classes. Two faculties have successfully attended 21 days refresher course at Fakir Mohan University. One faculty has attended 02 days National workshop on Action Research on Education at Gangadhar Meher University, Sambalpur. The HOD of the departments is the in charge of youth Red Cross (YRC) unit of the college and trained one. They also took keen interest in participating seminars at various levels. Teacher's participation in seminar activities is satisfactory. The department performed the best in academic result of the college. Some students also undergone add on courses. Performance of students in academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities is also satisfactory. The department has a seminar library but it needs upgrading with better study materials. The annual result of the department is satisfactory. One faculty member to complete M Phil by 2022 and other faculty to get admission into M.Phil by 2022. As many students without Mathematics enrolled in thishonours the department to conduct a Bridge Course for the students of +3 1st year only on Mathematics and it is to be conducted by the department of Mathematics. However, the faculty members may be encouraged to undertake major/ minor Research work on socially useful issues and articles for Publications in reputed journal. Budget analysis to be organised for the college by a CA every year. The Department to prepare a Question bank according to the current syllabus and pattern of examination. The faculty members to prepare objectives and outcomes for their respective papers. The department must have a WhatsApp group to share PPT and electronic resources to students (Refer- Annexure-2).

Education:

This department has one regular faculty member engaged primarily in teaching honours students for +3 (Degree) classes. She has completed M. Phil and one more vacancy will be fulfilled shortly. Many students are under going higher education. Teacher participation in seminar activities is satisfactory. Performance of students (Academic and extracurricular) is also satisfactory. Student's feedback on the institution is also satisfactory. The students of this department is doing the second best result of the college. The total nos. of books and journals in the seminar library is not up to the mark. So, it must be upgraded with better and more books, journals and reference materials. More focus to be given on meaningful social relevant research by faculty members. Faculties are to carry out major and minor research project works in the academic interest of students, teachers and other stakeholders. The faculty member to be encouraged for Ph.D. The faculty members to prepare objectives and outcomes for their respective papers. There must be a departmental Alumni association and their benefit to be utilised. The department to conduct seminar in time. The department will take responsibility of survey of quality teaching, any changes made in the courses to be recorded, preparation of question bank for survey, to conduct IQ

Two add on course to be launched on Attitude Awareness Programme and Relationship development programme. The department must have a WhatsApp group to share PPT and electronic resources to students (Refer-Annexure-3).

History:

This department has two regular faculties and are primarily engaged in both teaching and extension activities of +3 Degree honours students. Both are pursuing PhD. tentatively to be completed by this year end. The HOD of the department performing the duty of IQAC coordinator and the other one is Women's Hostel Superintend and Programme officer of 2nd NSS Girls Unit of the college. The participation of faculties is satisfactory. Participation of students in co-curricular and extracurricular activities are satisfactory. Both faculty members are member of Indian History Congress and odisha History Congress. Presently, the HOD of the department is the executive body of Odisha History Congress. Two departmental seminars have been conducted by the department this year. The department has regular feedback system and conducted student satisfaction survey. They encourage students for NCC, NSS, YRC and other voluntary works. Students are encouraged to undergo post Graduate programmes. The seminar library is not up to mark needs to be upgraded. Books of local history to be available in seminar library. Heritage/Museum day to be celebrated and virtual visit of museum to be done by the faculty members on the same day. One Add On course on 'Lord Kshirochara Gopinathas' project paper to be prepared and to be done for the students of other department students. Faculties are to publish more articles in reputed journals. They require to be encouraged to carry out minor/ major research works on social issues other than their subject. The faculty members to prepare objectives and outcomes for their respective papers. There must be a departmental Alumni association and their benefit to be utilised. Heritage cycling tour may be organised to the place like Balasore Municipality. One student must be sent to on Internship to district museum every year. ICHR may be approached for national Seminar. There must be a departmental Alumni association and their benefit to be utilised. The department must have a WhatsApp group to share PPT and electronic resources to students (Refer- Annexure-4).

Home science:

There are two faculties member and one demonstrator in the department primarily, engaged in teaching and practical work for n+3 Degree Honours students. The HOD of the department is also performing the duty of NSS programme officer of one Girls NSS Unit and the other one is performing the duty of Ranger's programme leader of the college. One of the faculties have done her M.Phil. Their participation of faculties in seminar and extension activities is satisfactory. The participation of students in cocurricular and extra-curricular activities is satisfactory. The department has one well equipped laboratory where the practical works are supervised properly by the demonstrator. The faculties are encouraging the students for participation of students in NSS, NCC, YRC and rover and ranger units of the colleges. The department has

opened a 'Sprout Counter' on payment once (Thursday) in a week as best practices. The seminar library of the dept is not up to the marks and needs to be upgraded with better reference materials. There must be a departmental Alumni association and Guest lecture to be conducted by the alumni of the department. They will feel happy in participating and sharing their knowledge with students of their college. Faculties to be encouraged to run add-on course on nutrition management, Alpana competition for outsiders in nearby villages, the same may be in college and boys to be included. The department to organise a food festival and may be open to outside persons. The faculty members must undertake major/ minor projects on relevant social issues and publication of articles in famous journals. The faculty members to prepare objectives and outcomes for their respective papers. The department must have a WhatsApp group to share PPT and electronic resources to students (Refer- Annexure-5).

Odia:

This department has two regular faculties members engaged primarily in teaching honours students for +3 (Degree) classes. Both faculty members have completed their Ph.D. Teacher participation in seminar activities is satisfactory. Performance of students (Academic and extracurricular) is also satisfactory. Student's feedback on the institution is also satisfactory. Students are encouraged by the faculty members to accept membership in NCC, NSS, YRc and Rover and ranger unit of the college. The students of the departments have admitted in higher education. The department will organise an Add On course on Creative Writing. There must be publication of articles of faculty members in reputed Odia literary Journals, i.e. Jhankar, Swar, Utkal Prasanga, in Fakir Mohan Sahitya Parishad, etc. The total nos. of books and journals in the seminar library is not up to the mark. So, it must be upgraded with better and more books, journals and reference materials. The faculty members to prepare objectives and outcomes for their respective papers. There must be a departmental Alumni association and their benefit to be utilised. The students of the department will be the members of various local and state level Odia Literary Associations. The department will conduct every year Correct Spelling Competition in Odia language as extension activities. PPt's to be prepared by the department on Odia language 'Akriti'. More focus to be given on meaningful social relevant research by faculty members. Faculties are to carry out major and minor research project works in the academic interest of students, teachers and other stakeholders. The department must have a WhatsApp group to share PPT and electronic resources to students (Refer-Annexure-6).

And Two days Leadership Training workshop at Fakir Mohan University. The HOD of the department has the additional responsibility of NSS programme Officer for Boys unit. Teacher participation in seminar activities is satisfactory. Performance of students (Academic and extracurricular) is also satisfactory. Student's feedback on the institution is also satisfactory. The total nos. of books and journals in the seminar library is not up to the mark. So, it must be upgraded with better and more books, journals and reference materials. More focus to be given on meaningful social relevant research by faculty members. Faculties are to carry out major and minor research project works in the academic interest of students, teachers and other stakeholders. The Students of the department to conduct survey on Govt schemes and welfare measures in slum areas. Debates on contemporary political issues to be organised by inviting local experts. Add On course on NGO management in Odia medium to be organised. The students of the department must attend the meetings of Panchayat Samiti, Zilla Parisad, virtual parliament as well as to campaign voter's awareness campaign and exit poll in the nearby villages. The faculty members to prepare objectives and outcomes for their respective papers. The department must have a WhatsApp group to share PPT and electronic resources to students (Refer- Annexure-8).

Sanskrit:

There are two regular faculty in the department primarily engaged in teaching +3 Degree Honours classes. One faculty member has completed M.Phil. The HOD of the department is performing the duty of Principal I/C cum Secretary since 2011. The department has opted the best practice 'Moral Teaching' and conducting classes time to time. The department organised seminar regularly. Student's participation in seminar and extracurricular activities is satisfactory.
